COMES NOW, Counsel for Complainant and files this Reply to Second Supplement to Respondent's Prehearing Exchange.

First, Respondent complains that he has not been provided copies of certain provisions in the Code of Federal Regulations. Respondent can access the Code of Federal Regulations at http://www.gpoaccess.gov/cfr/index.html.

Second, Respondent seeks to have documents that have been withheld pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) made a part of his Prehearing Exchange.
