Dear Mr. Kremers:

On June 9, 2008, the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Administrative Order (the Order), Docket No. SDWA-08-2008-0064, ordering the Lance Creek Water and Sewer District as owner and/or operator of the Lance Creek Public Water System (the System) to comply with various drinking water regulations issued by EPA under the Safe Drinking Water Act (the Act), 42 U.S.C. Section 300f et seq.

Our records indicate that the Lance Creek Water and Sewer District (Respondent) is in violation of the Administrative Order. Among other things, the Order included the following requirement (quoted from item 11, of the Order section on page 2 of the Order):

 Prior to June 30, 2008 and during each subsequent calendar quarter until a different sampling frequency is determined by EPA, and per the regulations thereafter, Respondent shall monitor for arsenic. 40 C.F.R. § 141.23. Respondent shall report analytical results to EPA within the first 10 days following the month in which sample results are received, as required by the drinking water regulations. 40 C.F.R. § 141.31(a). Respondent shall report any violation of the drinking water requirements to EPA within 48 hours. 40 C.F.R. § 141.31(b).

Respondent did not monitor for arsenic at the System during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter (April - June) of 2011 and failed to report this violation to EPA within 48 hours as required. EPA understands that this violation occurred during a time of operator transition at the System. EPA is considering additional enforcement action as a result of the non-compliance with the Order. Violating an administrative order may lead to (1) a penalty of up to \$37,500 per day per violation of the Order, and/or (2) a court injunction ordering compliance.
