**MOTION TO EXTEND TIME FOR ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE
RESOLUTION PROCESS**

On September 17, 2008, the Chief Administrative Law Judge issued an Order Initiating Alternative Dispute Resolution Process and Appointing Neutral (Order) in this matter. The Order provided that the Alternative Dispute Resolution Process (ADR) would terminate on November 17, 2008 absent an extension of time.

Counsel for Respondents has indicated that he will be providing information related to Respondents' ability to pay the proposed penalty, and intends to submit information to Complainant later this week.

Accordingly, Complainant requests that the ADR process be extended for 30-days. Counsel for Respondents concurs in the motion for a 30-day extension of the ADR process.


