To Whom it May Concern:

This letter is the SEP Completion Report and documents that PSC Metals, Inc. ("PSC") has completed the Supplemental Environmental Project, as required in the Consent Agreement and Final Order ("CAFO") referenced above, Paragraph 38, as follows:

Supplemental Environmental Project

- 38. Respondent must submit a SEP completion report to EPA within 45 days from the effective date of this CAFO. This report must contain the following information:
 - a. Documentation that a payment was made by PSC to the Knox County Public Schools;
 and
 - b. Statement from the Knox County Public Schools certifying that the money was received and has been put towards the BAS Project or a copy of a signed agreement between PSC and Knox County Public Schools specifying that the funds provided by PSC will be used for the BAS Project.

38.a. Documentation that a Payment was Made

Pursuant to communication with EPA, the effective date of the CAFO was February 9, 2017. On March 6, 2017, William Hansard, PSC Director of Environmental Affairs, sent a check in the amount of \$60,000 to Knox County Schools (PSC Check No. 406564) along with a letter agreement addressed to Zane Foraker, BAS Project Manager, Knox County Schools. The letter package was received and signed for by Knox County Schools on March 8, 2017, as shown in Attachment 1, Certified Mail Domestic Return Receipt.

38.b Statement and Signed Agreement from Knox County Public Schools

Mr. Zane Foraker wrote a letter to Mr. Joe King, Vice President and General Counsel of PSC Metals, Inc., dated March 9, 2017, confirming receipt of the \$60,000 check and stating that "Knox County Public Schools intends to put the money received from PSC Metals toward a Building Automation System ("BAS") which is part of an Energy Conservation Project at Farragut Middle School in Knoxville, Tennessee." This letter is enclosed as Attachment 2.

Mr. Foraker also signed and returned the letter agreement sent to him by William Hansard on March 6 for the BAS project. This letter agreement was prepared to meet the requirements of paragraph 38 of the CAFO and is included as Attachment 3.

Summary

PSC has completed all of the requirements for the SEP Completion Report, as stated in the CAFO paragraphs 34-40 and requests that EPA notify PSC in writing that it has met these obligations, as provided in paragraph 41 of the CAFO. The following certification for the SEP completion report is required pursuant to paragraph 40 of the CAFO.

I know that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fines and imprisonment for knowing violations.



RE: Letter Agreement for SEP/Energy Conservation Project at Farragut Middle School

Dear Mr. Foraker,

PSC Metals is pleased to offer the Knox County School system \$60,000 in partial funding for the Building Automation System Project at Farragut Middle School. A description of the BAS Project is included as Attachment A.

This offer is subject to the terms of the Consent Agreement and Final Order (CAFO-see Attachment B) between the USEPA and PSC Metals. One of the terms of this agreement is that PSC Metals contribute to a Supplemental Environmental Project. The BAS Project is the Supplemental Environmental Project selected for this CAFO.

The CAFO requires the following:

- 1. That PSC Metals pay \$60,000 in partial funding for the BAS within 30 days of execution of the CAFO (due March 10, 2017)
- 2. That PSC Metals submit a SEP completion report within 45 days from the effective date of the CAFO (due March 27, 2017)
- 3. The completion report must contain documentation that payment was made by PSC Metals to the Knox County Public Schools (A receipt and letter of transmittal is requested from you on receipt of the funds.)
- 4. A statement from the Knox County Public Schools certifying that the money was received and has been put towards the BAS Project or a copy of a signed agreement between PSC Metals and Knox County Public Schools specifying that the funds provided by PSC Metals will be used for the BAS Project.

Accordingly, PSC Metals agrees to pay \$60,000 in settlement of the SEP to Knox County Schools to satisfy paragraph 36 of the CAFO. Knox County Schools 1) agrees to provide documentation that the \$60,000 payment was made to Knox County Schools, and 2) agrees to support the SEP as indicated above and in the attachments, and 3) assures that the funds provided by PSC Metals will be used for the BAS Project.
