**Subject:** Closure of Administrative Order – YNP-Old Faithful WY5600085 Docket No. SDWA-08-2024-0049, Teton County

The EPA has decided to close the Administrative Order (Order) regarding the public water system specified in the subject line. The EPA has determined that there are no remaining requirements of the Order. The water system has not completed the construction project documented in the addendum; however, the system has been able to maintain compliance with the arsenic maximum contaminant level through process controls and the violations have been returned to compliance.

Please be aware that you are still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (drinking water regulations), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the drinking water regulations may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties.
