

REPORT RECOMMENDING NEW PERIOD OF  
ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The Report approved December 16, 2008 provides that this alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process terminates February 8, 2009. The recommendation of this Report is that a new period of ADR, not to exceed three months, be granted.

In a conference call on January 30, 2009, both parties requested an extension of the ADR process. The extension of the ADR process is recommended because the parties' negotiations have developed the possibility of a settlement and there are extraordinary circumstances warranting the extension.

Inasmuch as the undersigned is without authority to grant an extended period of ADR, the case is returned to the Chief Administrative Law Judge for resolution of the pending request. Thereafter, if the request for an extension of ADR is granted, the case should be returned to the undersigned for continuation of ADR.
