

EXTENSION OF THE DISPUTE RESOLUTION TIME PERIOD

Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.07(b) of the Consolidated Rules of Practice and in response to the Recommendation of Administrative Law Judge M. Linda Buschmann in her REPORT RECOMMENDING CONTINUATION OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION, dated January 10, 2013, Complainant, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), respectfully agree to the extension of the Alternative Dispute Resolution time period regarding the above captioned action, initiated pursuant to Sections 15 and 16 of the Toxic Substances Control Act ("TSCA"), 15 U.S.C. §§ 2614 and 2615, the regulations implementing TSCA Section 6(e), 15 U.S.C. § 2605(e), as set forth at 40 C.F.R. Part 761, and the Consolidated Rules of Practice Governing the Administrative Assessment of Civil Penalties, and the Revocation/Termination or Suspension of Permits ("Consolidated Rules of Practice"), 40 C.F.R. Part 22. Respondent's counsel also agrees to the extension of the Alternative Dispute Resolution time period regarding the above captioned action. Complainant and Respondent

believe that the settlement of this matter is possible. However, the parties deem it prudent to extend the Alternative Dispute Resolution time period to facilitate further settlement discussions at this time.
