**JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
FOR RESPONDENT TO FILE ANSWER**

Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §22.7(b), the Complainant and Respondent (“Parties”) respectfully request a 30-day extension (until April 23, 2008) for Respondent to file a written Answer to the Complainant’s Administrative Complaint. As grounds for this motion, the Parties state as follows:


1. On January 17, 2008, Complainant filed its Complaint in this action;
2. On January 17, 2008, Respondent spoke with Complainant and expressed its willingness to achieve an expeditious settlement of this matter;
3. Based upon this representation, the Parties filed a Joint Motion to Extend the Time for Respondent to file its Answer until March 24, 2008,¹ and the Hearing Officer granted this Motion;
4. The Parties began settlement negotiations on March 5, 2008 and remain actively involved in discussions;

¹ The Joint Motion for Extension of Time for Respondent to File Answer, filed February 19, 2008, notes March 22, 2008 as the date by which Respondent must file its Answer. However, March 22, 2008 is a Saturday, making March 24, 2008 the actual response date, pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §22.7(a).

5. An extension until April 23, 2008 will provide the Parties with sufficient time to negotiate the settlement of this matter.
