The EPA provides notice of the proposed assessment of a Class II civil penalty pursuant to 35. U.S.C. 1319(g)(4)(A). Class II proceedings are conducted under EPAs Consolidated Rules, 40 C.F.R. Part 22. in this case, the EPA is filing a Complaint against Respondent that alleges that the Respondent falled to obtain a permit required pursuant to Section 404 of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. 1344, and therefore violated Section 301 of the CWA, 33 U.S.C.
