Dear Mr. Erickson:

This letter is to inform you of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) decision to close the Order for Compliance, Docket No. CWA-08-2014-0003, issued to Coyote Septic Service, Inc. on October 29, 2013. The EPA has determined that Coyote Septic Service, Inc. has no remaining obligations under the Order and, therefore, is closing the Order at this time.

Please be aware that Coyote Septic Service, Inc. is still required to comply with the Clean Water Act (Act) and its implementing regulations, including the disposal of sewage sludge requirements pursuant to section 405 of the Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1345, and 40 C.F.R. part 503. Violations of the Act or its implementing regulations may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$37,500 per day for each violation.
