Re: 2nd Addendum to the Administrative Order issued to the Lambert County Sewer and Water District, PWS ID #MT0000269, Docket No. SDWA-08-2015-0001

Dear Mr. Hill:

On January 12, 2015, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Administrative Order (Order), Docket No. SDWA-08-2015-0001, ordering the Lambert County Sewer and Water District (District) to comply with various regulations issued by the EPA under the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. § 300f et seq, at the Lambert County Sewer and Water District Public Water System (System). The purpose of this letter is to incorporate into the Order an updated Plan and Schedule that was submitted on behalf of the District by Greg Lukasik of Great West Engineering, Inc., on May 8, 2015. All other terms and requirements of the Order remain in full force and effect until notified otherwise by the EPA.

The Plan and Schedule addresses how the District will return the System to compliance with the fluoride maximum contaminant level (MCL). This Addendum approves the schedule below for implementing treatment adjustments to prevent future fluoride MCL violations.

Lambert County Water and Sewer District Compliance Plan and Schedule

Action	Deadline Date
Complete design report and submit to DEQ for review	March 31, 2015 (completed)
DEQ Review and Approval obtained	July, 31, 2015
Materials for project ordered by	August 30, 2015
Project Completion (Installation of both skids)	September 30, 2015

Please note that the EPA expects this approved schedule to be met. Pursuant to paragraph 14 of the Order, the System shall achieve compliance with the fluoride MCL by the final compliance deadline in this approved schedule, September 30, 2015. The EPA is authorized to seek penalties if these deadlines are not met. If the District has a reasonable basis to believe it may be unable to meet any deadline in the schedule, it shall notify the EPA well in advance of the scheduled deadline to request an extension. The EPA may, in its discretion, consider granting an extension.

Please be advised that the District is required to comply with all provisions of the Order, including the above Plan and Schedule. Violation of any part of the Order may subject the District to civil penalties. Please contact Sienna Meredith, at 1-800-457-2690 or (406) 457-5026 if you have any questions concerning this Addendum.
