Dear Mr. Kizhakkekutu:

On March 29, 2021, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Underground Storage Tank (UST) Section issued a Notice of Violation and a Compliance Order/Settlement Agreement (Field Citation) concerning an UST violation (i.e., failure to monitor tanks every 30 days) found at the BP Amoco facility located at 342 East 35th Street, Chicago, Illinois. The Citation was modified on May 6, 2021 after EPA accepted documentation on compliance for one of the two counts.

On May 26, 2021, we have received your signed copy of the Settlement Agreement and supporting documentation. Also, on July 12, 2021 the EPA finance office confirmed receipt of your payment (check #5476) for a total of \$670.00 in penalties. In addition, EPA returned your first check (#5462) to you on July 13, 2021, after it arrived late. A copy of this returned check marked "void", per your request, is enclosed.

The Settlement Agreement states that it is effective upon EPA's final approval. I have enclosed a signed and dated copy of the approved Settlement Agreement. The original Settlement Agreement will remain in the EPA's files. We also have accepted and processed your second check as part of the settlement process.
