Mr. Kellman and Mr. Haller,

The EPA has decided to close the Administrative Order (Order) regarding the public water system specified in the subject line. The EPA has determined that there are no remaining requirements of the Order. The system implemented a corrective action plan to lower Disinfection Byproducts to levels below the maximum contaminant levels.

Please be aware that you are still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (drinking water regulations), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the drinking water regulations may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties.
