LEGAL AUTHORITY

This Consent Agreement is proposed and entered into under the authority vested in the Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency by Section 311(b)(6)(B)(i) of the Clean Water Act (“CWA”), 33 U.S.C. § 1321(b)(6)(B)(i), as amended by the Oil Pollution Act of 1990, and under the authority provided by 40 C.F.R. §§ 22.13(b) and 22.18(b)(2). The Administrator has delegated these authorities to the Regional Administrator of EPA, Region 4, who has in turn delegated these authorities through the Director, RCRA Division, to the Chief, RCRA and OPA Enforcement and Compliance Branch, RCRA Division (“Complainant”).

CONSENT AGREEMENT

Complainant and Respondent have conferred for the purpose of settlement pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.18 and desire to settle this action. Accordingly, before any testimony has been taken upon the pleadings and without any admission of violation or adjudication of any issue of fact or law and in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 22.13(b), Complainant and Respondent have agreed to execute this Consent Agreement and Final Order (CA/FO), and Respondent hereby agrees to comply with the terms of this CA/FO. For purposes of this CA/FO and settlement of this action, Respondent admits to the jurisdictional statements contained herein.

Stipulations

1. The Respondent, Ace Transport, LLC, is a limited liability company organized under the laws of North Carolina. Respondent is a person within the meaning of Section 311(a)(7) of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. § 1321(a)(7).

2. The Respondent is the “owner and operator” within the meaning of Section 311(a)(6) of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. § 1321(a)(6) of a tanker truck (facility) at the time relevant to this CA/FO.

3. The facility is an “onshore facility” within the meaning of Section 311(a)(10) of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. § 1321(a)(10).

4. The facility was located, at the time relevant to this CA/FO, on the 1-40 East off-ramp to US 220, in Greensboro, Guilford County, North Carolina.

5. Buffalo Creek is a navigable water, as defined in Section 502(7) of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. § 1362(7), and 40 C.F.R. § 110.1, and is therefore subject to the jurisdiction of Section 311 of the CWA, 42 U.S.C. § 1321.

6. Section 311(b)(3) of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. § 1321(b)(3), prohibits the discharge of oil into or upon the navigable waters of the United States or adjoining shorelines in such quantities as may be harmful.

7. Pursuant to Section 311(b)(4) of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. § 1321(b)(4), the criteria for determining the quantities of oil that may be harmful and thereby prohibited under Section 311(b)(3), 33 U.S.C. § 1321(b)(3), are codified at 40 C.F.R. § 110.3 to include discharges of oil that (1) violate applicable water quality standards or (2) cause a film or a sheen upon or discoloration of the surface of the water or adjoining shorelines or cause a sludge or emulsion to be deposited beneath the surface of the water or upon the adjoining shorelines.

Allegations

The Complainant alleges, and the Respondent neither admits nor denies, that:

8. On November 29, 2011, the Respondent discharged approximately 1,200 gallons of oil, as defined in Section 311(a)(1) of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. § 1321(a)(1), from its facility into or upon Buffalo Creek and/or its adjoining shorelines.

9. The discharge described above caused a sheen upon or discoloration of the surface of Buffalo Creek and/or its adjoining shorelines and caused a sludge or emulsion to be deposited beneath the surface of the water or upon its adjoining shorelines, and, therefore, was in a quantity that has been determined to be harmful under 40 C.F.R. § 110.3.

10. Accordingly, the Respondent violated Section 311(b)(3) of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. § 1321(b)(3).

Waiver of Rights

11. Solely for the purpose of this CA/FO, the Respondent waives the right to contest the allegations contained herein, to a hearing under Section 311(b)(6)(B)(i) of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. § 1321(b)(6)(B)(i), to appeal any Final Order in this matter under Section 311(b)(6)(G)(i) of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. § 1321(b)(6)(G)(i), and consents to the issuance of a Final Order without further adjudication.

Terms of Agreement

12. The Complainant proposes, and the Respondent consents to pay a civil penalty of SIX THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$6,300.00).

13. By executing this CA/FO, the Respondent certifies that all violations alleged herein have been corrected.

Payment Terms

Based on the foregoing, the parties, in their own capacity or by their attorney or authorized representatives, hereby agree that:

14. No later than 30 days after the effective date of the CA/FO, the Respondent shall pay the amount of Six Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$6,300.00) by means of a corporate

cashier's or certified check, by electronic funds transfer (EFT), or on-line. If paying by check, the Respondent shall submit a corporate cashier's or certified check, payable to the "Environmental Protection Agency," and bearing the notation "OSLTF – 311" and the Respondent shall also note the facility name and docket number of this case.

16. Penalties paid pursuant to this CA/FO are not deductible for federal tax purposes pursuant to 26 U.S.C. § 162(f).

17. The Respondent's failure to pay the penalty assessed by the Final Order in full by its due date may subject the Respondent to a civil action to collect the assessed penalty, plus interest, attorney's fees, costs and an additional quarterly nonpayment penalty pursuant to Section 311(b)(6)(H) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1321(b)(6)(H). In any such collection action, the validity, amount and appropriateness of the penalty agreed to herein shall not be subject to review.

General Provisions

18. The Final Order shall be binding upon the Respondent and the Respondent's officers, directors, agents, and successors or assigns.

19. The Final Order does not constitute a waiver, suspension or modification of the requirements of Section 311 of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. § 1321, or any regulations promulgated thereunder, and does not affect the right of the Administrator or the United States to pursue any applicable injunctive or other equitable relief or criminal sanctions for any violation of law.

Payment of the penalty pursuant to this Consent Agreement resolves only the Respondent's liability for federal civil penalties for the violations and facts stipulated to and alleged herein.

20. The undersigned representative of the Respondent hereby certifies that he/she is fully authorized to enter into and execute this Consent Agreement and to legally bind the Respondent to the terms and conditions of this CA/FO.






