Enclosed, please find an executed copy of the Expedited Settlement Agreement (ESA) that resolves the Clean Air Act (CAA) matter (Docket No. CAA-04-2011-8020(b)) involving Sara Lee Corporation. EXPEDITED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This ESA is issued to: Sara Lee Corporation 2000 Biffle Road Newbern, TN 38059

for violating 40 CFR § 68.69, 40 CFR § 68.71, and Section 112(r)(7) of the Clean Air Act.

This Expedited Settlement Agreement (ESA) is being entered into by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 4, the Director of the Air, Pesticides and Toxics Management Division (Complainant), and by Sara Lee Corporation (Respondent), pursuant to Section 113(d) of the Clean Air Act (the "Act"), 42 U.S.C. § 7413(d), and pursuant to 40 CFR § 22.13(b).

ALLEGED VIOLATIONS

Based on a compliance monitoring inspection conducted at the Respondent's facility located at 2000 Biffle Road, Newbern, Tennessee, on August 3, 2010, the EPA alleges that the Respondent violated the Act's Chemical Accident Prevention Program when at the time of inspection, Respondent did not provide evidence that:

It has developed and implemented safe work practices to provide for the control of hazards during specific operations, such as lockout/tagout procedures as required by 40 CFR § 68.69(d); and

It has maintained training records, for each employee involved in operating its process, that document the means by which the Respondent used to verify that its employees understood such training as required by 40 CFR § 68.71(c).

<u>SETTLEMENT</u>

In consideration of Respondent's size, its full compliance history, its good faith effort to comply, and other factors as justice may require, and upon consideration of the entire record the parties enter into the ESA in order to settle the violation cited above, for the total penalty amount of **\$1500**.

This settlement is subject to the following terms and conditions: the Respondent by signing below admits the jurisdictional allegations contained herein, neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained herein, and consents to the assessment of the penalty as stated above; Respondent waives its rights to a hearing afforded by Section 113(d)(2)(A) of the Act, 42 U.S.C § 7413(d)(2)(A), and to contest the allegations contained in this ESA; and each party to this action shall bear its own costs and fees, if any.

Respondent certifies, subject to civil and criminal penalties for making a false submission to the United States Government, that the Respondent has corrected the alleged violations listed in this ESA. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$1500. Please note that payment <u>should not</u> be made until after Respondent receives a copy of the <u>fully executed</u> ESA. Within fifteen (15) days of receiving a copy of the fully executed ESA, the Respondent shall send a cashier's check or certified check (payable to the "Treasurer, United States of America") in the amount of \$1500, in payment of the full penalty amount to one of the following addresses:
