

REPORT RECOMMENDING CONTINUATION  
OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The Report approved May 31, 2012 provides that this alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process terminates July 11, 2012. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be continued for a *final* month, to August 13, 2012.

This continuation of the ADR process is recommended because the parties have agreed to settle this matter, but additional time is needed for the execution of the Consent Agreement and Final Order ("CAFO"). Accordingly, the undersigned will continue to work as a Neutral in this case and will file another report with the Chief Administrative Law Judge by August 13, 2012 unless otherwise directed by her. 
