

ORDER DISMISSING ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

Complainant by Motion, dated July 2, 2004, has moved to withdraw the complaint in this protracted proceeding under Section 325 of the Emergency Planning and Community Right to Know Act, 42 U.S.C. § 11001 *et seq.* The motion recites, *inter alia*, that the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Kentucky, to which the Bankruptcy case has been removed. (In re *Norcross Footwear, Inc.*, Case No. 3:03-CV-5(H) issued an Order on January 30, 2004, directing the *pro rata* distribution of funds to unsecured creditors, that pursuant to that order, U.S. EPA Region 5 has received its *pro rata* distribution of funds in the amount of \$18,600 and that Respondent has fully complied with its responsibilities under the Settlement Agreement filed with the court on July 12, 1999, and approved by the court on August 6, 1999.

In view of the foregoing, the motion is granted and this proceeding is DISMISSED.


