## ORDER ON JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On June 4, 2019, I issued a Prehearing Order setting forth various deadlines in this case, including for the filing of prehearing exchanges or a fully-executed Consent Agreement and Final Order ("CAFO").

On July 10, 2019, the parties filed a Joint Motion for Extension of Time indicating that they have agreed to a settlement but need more time to finish drafting a CAFO. They request an extension of the Prehearing Order's deadline of July 12, 2019.

This Tribunal "may grant an extension of time for filing any document: upon timely motion of a party to the proceeding, for good cause shown, and after consideration of prejudice to other parties; or upon its own initiative." 40 C.F.R. § 22.7(b).

In this case, I find there is good cause for an extension of time. Consequently, the parties' joint motion is **GRANTED**. The parties have through **August 30, 2019**, to file a fully-executed CAFO as directed in the Prehearing Order. If a fully-executed CAFO is not filed, the parties shall adhere to prehearing exchange deadlines that are extended as follows:

August 30, 2019	Complainant's Initial Prehearing Exchange
<b>September 20, 2019</b>	Respondent's Prehearing Exchange
October 4, 2019	Complainant's Rebuttal Prehearing
