REPORT RECOMMENDING TERMINATION OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS AND ASSIGNMENT OF A JUDGE FOR LITIGATION

The Order of August 15, 2013 provides that this alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process terminates September 23, 2013. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be terminated, and that the case be assigned to a Judge for resolution through litigation.

The reason for this recommendation is that the parties, after four months of the ADR process, have not reached a settlement. Accordingly, the case should now be assigned to a Judge to preside over a litigated resolution of this case.
