

REPORT RECOMMENDING CONTINUATION  
OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The Report approved February 9, 2015 provides that this alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process terminates March 23, 2015. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be continued until April 23, 2015.

This continuation of the ADR process is recommended because the parties' negotiations have made significant progress toward a settlement, but additional time is needed if a settlement is to be actually concluded. In a conference call on March 19, 2015 both parties agreed that the ADR process should be continued. The parties' chances of achieving a settlement are sufficient to justify the requested continuation.

Accordingly, the undersigned will continue to work as a Neutral in this case and will file another report with the Chief Administrative Law Judge by April 23, 2015, unless otherwise directed by her.
