#### ORDER SCHEDULING POST-HEARING SUBMISSIONS

The hearing in this matter was conducted April 3-5, 2018, in Albany, New York. The Headquarters Hearing Clerk subsequently received the official transcript of testimony taken at the hearing, and electronic copies of this transcript were provided by email to counsel for the parties on May 10, 2018.

Any motion to conform the transcript to the actual testimony shall be filed on or before **Monday, June 11, 2018**. *See* 40 C.F.R. § 22.25. The parties may file any such motion jointly or separately.

As provided for in the rules governing this proceeding, the parties "may file proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and a proposed order, together with briefs in support thereof." 40 C.F.R. § 22.26. At the hearing, it was agreed that the parties would submit posthearing briefs in sequential order, beginning with Complainant's initial brief. Thus, the parties shall file post-hearing briefs in accordance with the following schedule:

Complainant's Initial Post-Hearing Brief Friday, July 6, 2018

Respondent's Initial Post-Hearing Brief Friday, July 27, 2018

Complainant's Reply Post-Hearing Brief Friday, August 17, 2018

Respondent's Reply Post-Hearing Brief Friday, September 7, 2018

All briefs shall contain specific citations to the record and to any legal authority the party wishes for this Tribunal to consider. *See* 40 C.F.R. § 22.26 (requiring all post-hearing submissions to contain adequate references to the record and authorities upon which the filing party relied). If a party does not intend to file a post-hearing brief or reply brief as permitted above, it shall notify Jennifer Almase, a staff attorney for this Tribunal, at (202) 564-1170 or almase.jennifer@epa.gov.
