ORDER ON COMPLAINANT’S MOTION TO EXTEND STAY

This proceeding was initiated on December 18, 2024, when Complainant, the Director of the Enforcement and Compliance Assurance Division in Region 10 of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA” or “Agency”), filed a Complaint against Respondent Jackson & Son Distributors, Inc., doing business as Jackson and Son Oil, pursuant to Section 311(b)(6) of the Clean Water Act (“CWA”), 33 U.S.C. § 1321(b)(6). At the parties’ request, I issued an Order on July 21, 2026, staying further proceedings until August 7, 2026, based on the parties’ representation that they had reached a settlement in principle and that the requested stay would afford them sufficient time to fully execute a Consent Agreement and Final Order. On that date, however, Complainant moved to extend the stay by one week until August 14, 2026. Complainant explains in its Motion to Extend Stay that while Respondent has signed the Consent Agreement, Complainant is still seeking a final signature, after which it will file the Consent Agreement and Final Order with the Regional Hearing Clerk and file a courtesy copy with this Tribunal. Complainant represents that Respondent consents to its request.

As noted in previous orders, the interests of the parties and judicial economy are well served by the parties resolving this matter informally and expeditiously, and the governing procedural rules reflect an Agency policy supporting settlement of a proceeding without the necessity of a formal hearing. See 40 C.F.R. § 22.18(b)(1). Here, Complainant has requested a brief extension of a stay in order to achieve that outcome, and Respondent does not object. Accordingly, good cause has been shown, and the Motion to Extend Stay is **GRANTED**. This proceeding is hereby stayed until August 14, 2026. If the case is settled, a fully-executed Consent Agreement and Final Order shall be filed with the Regional Hearing Clerk, and a courtesy copy shall be filed with this Tribunal, by that date.

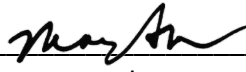
