

REPORT RECOMMENDING CONTINUATION
OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The Report approved June 13, 2012 provides that this alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process terminates August 9, 2012. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be continued for a *final* month to September 10, 2012.

This continuation of the ADR process is recommended because the parties' negotiations have developed the possibility of a settlement, but additional time is needed if a settlement is to be actually concluded. In a conference call on August 8, 2012 the parties agreed that the ADR process should be continued.

Accordingly, the undersigned will continue to work as a Neutral in this case and will file another report with the Chief Administrative Law Judge by September 10, 2012 unless otherwise directed by her.
