

REPORT RECOMMENDING CONTINUATION
OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The Chief Administrative Law Judge's Order of November 20, 2014 provides that this alternative dispute resolution ("ADR") process terminates January 19, 2015. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be continued for one month, to February 19, 2015.
