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

ORDER ON JOINT MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDINGS

On May 30, 2014, Respondent, the Assistant Administrator for Chemical Safety and Pollution Prevention, Environmental Protection Agency, and Petitioner Reckitt Benckiser LLC (“Reckitt”), filed a Joint Motion to Stay Proceedings, requesting therein a stay of this proceeding for 75 days. The moving parties state that they have entered into a memorandum of agreement (“MOA”) that will obviate the need for a hearing in this matter, as it provides that Reckitt will withdraw the applications at issue, and will request that the registrations at issue be cancelled voluntarily pursuant to FIFRA Section 6(f). 7 U.S.C. § 136d(f)(1). Notice of the voluntary cancellation will be published in the Federal Register and Respondent will consider any comments received. Respondent states that it intends to grant the cancellation request.

The parties report in the Joint Motion that Petitioners Louisville Apartment Association and Greater Cincinnati Northern Kentucky Apartment Association have no objection to the stay sought, and that Intervenor has no position on the motion pending further review of the MOA.

Pursuant to the rules governing this proceeding, set forth at 40 C.F.R. Part 164, the Joint Motion is hereby **GRANTED** for good cause shown, all pending filing deadlines are suspended until and unless they are rescheduled by order, and this proceeding is stayed until August 18, 2014. 40 C.F.R. § 164.6(b).
