ORDER DENYING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION FOR ACCELERATED DECISION AND DENYING RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS COUNT III

On May 12, 1995¹, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 5 (complainant), filed an accelerated decision motion on the liability issue. A & V, Inc. (respondent or AV), responded in opposition to the motion on May 31. Additionally, in its opposition, respondent included a motion to dismiss count III for failure to establish a prima facie case. Complainant filed its response in opposition to the dismissal motion on June 8. The arguments of the parties have been weighed.

Under 40 C.F.R. § 22.20(a), an accelerated decision should only be granted where no genuine issue of material fact exists, and a party is entitled to judgment as a matter of law. The Administrative Law Judge is of the mind that genuine issues of material fact exist regarding the alleged violations. First, under counts I and II, respondent contests the accuracy of complainant's testing methods and procedures which form the basis of whether or not respondent sold an alleged "adulterated" and/or "misbranded" pesticide, in violation of Section 12(a)(1)(E) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), 7 U.S.C. §

viewed with favor under the standard enunciated in 40 C.F.R. § 22.20(a).

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Complainant's motion for an accelerated decision be <u>DENTED</u>.
- 2. Respondent's motion to dismiss count III be DENIED.
