OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS


The Chief Administrative Law Judge's Order of January 21, 2009 provides that this alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process terminates March 23, 2009. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be continued for another month, to April 23, 2009.

This continuation of the ADR process is recommended because the parties' negotiations have developed a settlement in principle but additional time is needed for the preparation and filing of the Consent Agreement and Final Order ("CAFO"). In a conference call on March 18, 2009, the parties indicated their agreement on continuing the ADR process for another month.


