

REPORT RECOMMENDING CONTINUATION
OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The Report approved March 18, 2009 provides that this alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process terminates April 23, 2009. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be continued for a final month, to May 23, 2009.

This continuation of the ADR process is recommended because the parties have agreed to settle this matter, but additional time is needed for the execution of the Consent Agreement and Final Order ("CAFO"). Accordingly, the undersigned will continue to work as a Neutral in this case and will file another report with the Chief Administrative Law Judge by May 23, 2009 unless otherwise directed by her.
