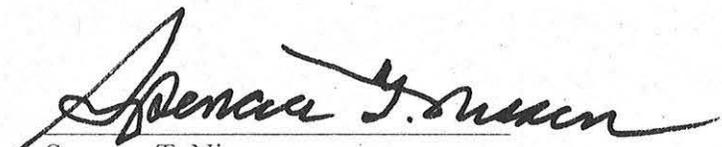

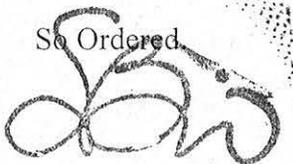
ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF  
ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

Complainant has filed an unopposed motion for a 30-day extension of time to continue the alternative Dispute Resolution process. ADR expires on July 6, 2009. The parties have represented that they are presently making good progress in their settlement negotiations. Specifically, the extension will allow the Complainant (through its financial consulting expert) to perform a thorough financial analysis of Respondent's ability to pay the penalty proposed. Additionally, the extension will provide the parties with time to address compliance issues. For good cause shown, the time period provided for ADR is extended to and including August 6, 2009.
