The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has determined, pursuant to Section XXIX (Notice of Completion of Work) of the referenced Administrative Settlement Agreement and Order on Consent for Removal Action (Settlement Agreement), that the Work required by the Settlement Agreement has been fully performed. In addition, the EPA has received payment for oversight and additional costs per our most recent invoice. Accordingly, the Settlement Agreement is hereby terminated, except as to any continuing obligations posed by the records preservation and reservation of rights provisions of the Settlement Agreement.

Mission Clay Products is expected to continue to comply with the Long-Term Care Agreement (LTCA) and Environmental Use Control (EUC) agreements entered into by it with the Kansas Department of Health and Environment and documented in Attachment E of the enclosed Final Project Report. Failure to comply with the LTCA and EUC could adversely affect the removal action and lead to further exposures, health risks and liabilities.
