Settlement Status Report

The Prehearing Order dated February 19, 2019 directed the parties to engage in a settlement conference on or before March 8, 2019 and directs the parties to attempt to reach an amicable resolution of this matter. The Order also directs the Complainant to file a Status Report regarding this conference and the status of settlement on or before March 15, 2019.

On February 26, Complainant sent an initial letter to Respondent with a series of dates to schedule the initial settlement conference as well as reference to *the Office of Administrative Law Judge's Citizen's Guide* (October 2010). The parties held the initial settlement conference on March 8. During the week of March 11th, Complainant has engaged with Respondent on setting up subsequent settlement discussions. The parties have scheduled a settlement discussion for March 19.

Both parties have expressed an interest in settlement and are continuing to evaluate options.
