

REPORT RECOMMENDING CONTINUATION
OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The Chief Administrative Law Judge's Order of November 8, 2007 provides that this alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process terminates January 7, 2008. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be continued for another month, to February 7, 2008.

This continuation of the ADR process is recommended because the parties' negotiations have developed a settlement in principle but additional time is needed for the preparation and filing of the Consent Agreement and Final Order ("CAFO"). In a status report dated January 4, 2008, the parties agreed on continuing the ADR process for another month.¹


