THIRD SUPPLEMENT TO COMPLAINANT'S PREHEARING EXCHANGE

Complainant, United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 8 (EPA), by and through the undersigned, pursuant to section 22.19(f) of the Consolidated Rules of Practice (40 C.F. R. 40 C.F.R. § 22.19(f)), hereby supplements its Prehearing Exchange with the addition of two witnesses and Complainant's Exhibits CX68-CX77. A revised comprehensive list of Complainant's Exhibits is attached as Attachment A (Complainant's Updated Exhibit Index List, Version 3).

I. Complainant's Additional Witnesses

Brad W. Miller (Expert Witness)

Dr. Miller is a physical scientist in the EPA's National Enforcement Investigations

Center (NEIC) in Lakewood, Colorado. Dr. Miller holds a Ph.D. in Forestry from Virginia

Polytechnic Institute and State University, with a focus on soil chemistry. At NEIC, Dr. Miller works as a principal analytical chemist and project manager supervising the characterization of waste samples. Dr. Miller also selects analytical methods for the analysis of waste materials and ensures this analysis is performed within required quality control guidelines. Finally, Dr. Miller prepares expert reports and presents expert witness testimony. Dr. Miller has worked for the

EPA over 13 years. Dr. Miller started his work at the EPA as a post doctorate contractor and then joined NEIC in 2013. Dr. Miller will provide testimony in support of the EPA's determination that at least 20 of the drums of waste at Respondent's Salt Lake City Facility, at the time of the NEIC inspection, contained hazardous waste. Dr. Miller's expert report, entitled Hazardous Waste Characteristic of Yellow Primer Drums (August 5, 2022), is identified as CX75 on Complainant's Updated Exhibit List. Dr. Miller's curriculum vitae is identified as Appendix A to CX75.

Marc Callaghan (Fact Witness)

Mr. Callaghan is a Special Agent in the EPA's Criminal Investigation Division (EPA CID) in Idaho. Mr. Callaghan has been a special agent with the EPA for 14 years. Mr. Callaghan's current job title is National Forensics Coordinator. Mr. Callaghan is expected to testify about information gathered during his investigation of Respondent's compliance with RCRA regulations. Mr. Callaghan's testimony will include his review of the investigative activity reports in the Prime, Inc., criminal investigation.

Mr. Callaghan is also expected to provide a foundation for authentication of Agency records he created, maintained and/or reviewed in his role as Special Agent and custodian of EPA CID records to the extent that admissibility of such records remains in dispute at hearing. Mr. Callaghan's affidavit is identified as CX76 on Complainant's Updated Exhibit List. Mr. Callaghan's resume is identified as CX77 on Complainant's Updated Exhibit List.

Complainant also reserves the right to call any of Respondent's witnesses listed in Respondent's Prehearing Exchange, on rebuttal.
