

REPORT RECOMMENDING CONTINUATION
OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The Report approved May 17, 2012 provides that this alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process terminates June 30, 2012. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be continued for a *Final* two months, to August 30, 2012.

This continuation of the ADR process is recommended because the parties' negotiations are ongoing and the parties agree that the ADR process should be continued. Further, due to the extenuating and exceptional circumstances presented in this case, an additional period of ADR is warranted.

Accordingly, the undersigned will continue to work as a Neutral in this case and will file another report with the Chief Administrative Law Judge by August 30, 2012 unless otherwise directed by her.


