POST-HEARING SCHEDULING ORDER

The hearing in this matter was conducted on April 7, 2015, in Yakima, Washington. On April 16, 2015, the Hearing Clerk of this Tribunal received the official transcript of testimony taken at the hearing. The Hearing Clerk thereafter e-mailed an electronic copy of the transcript to counsel for the parties on April 20, 2015.

As indicated on the record at the hearing, and as provided for by 40 C.F.R. §§ 22.25 and 22.26, the parties may file motions to conform the transcript to the actual testimony, initial posthearing briefs with proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, and reply briefs. Accordingly, this Order hereby establishes filing deadlines for motions to conform the transcript and post-hearing briefs as follows:

- Any party may file a motion to conform the transcript to the actual testimony no later than <u>Wednesday, May 20, 2015</u>. The parties may file a joint motion to conform or separate motions to conform.
- If Complainant chooses to file a post-hearing brief, including proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, it shall file and serve its post-hearing brief no later than <u>Friday</u>, <u>June 5</u>.
- If Respondents choose to file a post-hearing brief, including proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, they shall file and serve their post-hearing brief no later than **Friday**, **June 19**.
- If Complainant chooses to file a reply brief, it shall file and serve its reply brief no later than **Friday, July 10**.

• If Respondents choose to file a reply brief, they shall file and serve their reply brief no later than **Friday, July 24**.

All submissions shall be in writing and shall contain adequate references to the record and authorities upon which the filing party relied. 40 C.F.R. § 22.26. If any party does not intend to file a post-hearing brief or reply brief as authorized above, it shall notify Jennifer Almase, a staff attorney for this Tribunal, at almase.jennifer@epa.gov or (202) 564-1170.
