### ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

By Joint Motion dated July 28, 2008, the parties moved for a 90 day extension of time to file the Consent Agreement and Final Order (CAFO).

The Motion is hereby, GRANTED, as set forth below:

Section 22.7(b) of the Rules of Practice (40 C.F.R. § 22.7(b)) provides that the Presiding Officer may grant an extension of time for filing any document upon timely motion of a party to the proceeding, for good cause shown, and after consideration of prejudice to other parties.

Good cause exists for the granting of the Motion in that it is in the interest of the parties and judicial economy for the parties to settle this matter on mutually agreeable terms rather than litigate the matter to conclusion. The Motion indicates that the parties had reached an agreement in principle and were in the process of completing a Consent Agreement, when on July 18, 2008, Respondent filed a Chapter 11 bankruptcy petition in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Connecticut (Case no. 08-50643). The parties represent that such filing significantly complicates the procedures necessary to complete the settlement necessitating the long extension requested. Therefore, the parties shall have until October 31, 2008 to file the fully executed Consent Agreement and Final Order.
