## STATUS REPORT AND MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE CONSENT AGREEMENT AND FINAL ORDER

Pursuant to the July 7, 2015 Prehearing Order, and pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §§ 22.7(b) and 22.16, Complainant, with the concurrence of the Respondent, submits this status report regarding settlement, along with a motion requesting an extension of time in which to file a Consent Agreement and Final Order.

In response to the Prehearing Order requirement that the parties hold a settlement conference by July 24, 2015, the parties' legal counsel have, since that date, had several phone calls. On May 19, 2015, the parties and their legal counsel met to discuss possible settlement. Based on that meeting, and subsequent phone calls, the parties are optimistic that this case will settle, thereby furthering the Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") policy supporting settlement, and avoiding the unnecessary expenditure of time and financial resources by both the Respondent and the agency.

However, as the parties are negotiating a complex "innovative technology" Supplemental Environmental Project ("SEP") as part of the settlement, and as such SEP, in addition to having

to be negotiated by the parties, also needs to be coordinated and approved by EPA Headquarters, and in light of August vacation schedules, the parties will need a limited amount of additional time in order to finalize settlement, and, therefore, the parties request a delay in which to file a fully-executed Consent Agreement and Final Order, until September 25, 2015.

Pursuant to the Prehearing Order, Complainant has contacted the Respondent's attorney and he has no objection regarding this motion.
