ORDER GRANTING SECOND JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSIONS OF TIME

The hearing in this matter was conducted April 3-5, 2018, in Albany, New York. After the Headquarters Hearing Clerk received the official transcript of testimony taken at the hearing, electronic copies of the transcript were provided by email to counsel for the parties, and I issued an Order Scheduling Post-Hearing Submissions, which established deadlines for the parties to file any motion to conform the transcript to the actual testimony and post-hearing briefs.

At the request of the parties, those deadlines were subsequently extended by an Order Granting Joint Motion for Extensions of Time, dated June 12, 2018. On June 14, 2018, Respondent filed a second Joint Motion for Extensions of Time ("Motion") on behalf of the parties, which requests another extension of the deadline to file motions to conform the transcript to the actual testimony from June 15 to June 22, 2018. As grounds for this request, the Motion states that "it has become apparent that the errors [in the transcript] are even more extensive than originally perceived" and that "[c]orrection of these error [sic] has proven difficult and time consuming—necessitating consultation with witnesses and substantial document review."

This matter is governed by the Consolidated Rules of Practice Governing the Administrative Assessment of Civil Penalties and the Revocation/Termination or Suspension of Permits ("Rules of Practice") set forth at 40 C.F.R. Part 22. The Rules of Practice provide that I "may grant an extension of time for filing any document: upon timely motion of a party to the proceeding, for good cause shown, and after consideration of prejudice to other parties; or upon its own initiative." 40 C.F.R. § 22.7(b).

Here, the Motion shows good cause for the requested extension. Accordingly, the Motion is hereby **<u>GRANTED</u>**. As requested by the parties, any motions to conform the transcript to the actual testimony shall be filed no later than **June 22, 2018**.
