MOTION FOR A STAY IN PROCEEDINGS

COMES NOW the Complainant, United States Environmental Protection Agency Region 7 (Complainant or EPA) and avers and moves as follows:

- The Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) period for this matter ended on December
 2012, and the case was referred to Judge Susan Biro on January 2, 2013.
- 2. During the ADR period, discussions between Counsel for TNT General Contracting, Inc. (TNT) and the Gary and Carol Trump Trust (the Trust) and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) resulted in MDNR approaching EPA and requesting that EPA agree

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to allow MDNR to take an enforcement action against TNT and the Trust. This request did not

extend to Webb Minerals, LLC (Webb).

3. The EPA agreed to this arrangement, but advised Counsel for TNT and the Trust as

well as MDNR that the EPA would not move to modify or dismiss any parties from the instant

action until the MDNR enforcement action was embodied in an enforceable consent agreement.

However, EPA indicated that it would move this Court to stay these proceedings to allow time

for TNT, the Trust and MDNR to negotiate such an agreement.

4. The undersigned Counsel for EPA therefore respectfully requests that these

proceedings be stayed for a period of ninety days to give TNT, the Trust and MDNR sufficient

time to come to an agreement regarding the civil penalties to be paid by TNT and MDNR, as

well as any other relief agreed to among the parties. If the ninety-day stay period should expire

without TNT, the Trust and MDNR having entered into an enforceable agreement regarding

penalties and other relief, EPA will evaluate at that time whether to move this Court for another

stay or to advise the Court that EPA would like to proceed to hearing.

5. Counsel for Complainant hereby represents that I have consulted with Counsel for

TNT and the Trust, and also with Counsel for Webb Minerals, LLC, and that none of the

Respondents will oppose this motion.
