ORDER ON COMPLAINANT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On September 26, 2018, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 1, ("Agency") initiated this proceeding by filing a Complaint against Respondent under Section 3008(a) of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 42 U.S.C. § 6928(a).

On July 29, 2019, the Agency filed a Motion to Strike the Third and Sixteenth Defenses from Respondent's Answer. After receiving an extension of time, Respondent submitted its response brief on August 23, 2019, and the Agency was given until September 3, 2019 to file a reply.

On August 29, 2019, the Agency requested an extension of time to file its reply brief, because counsel for the Agency will be on vacation. The Agency represents that Respondent consents to the extension.

This Tribunal "may grant an extension of time for filing any document: upon timely motion of a party to the proceeding, for good cause shown, and after consideration of prejudice to other parties; or upon its own initiative." 40 C.F.R. § 22.7(b).

In this case, I find there is good cause for an extension of time. Consequently, the Agency may file a reply brief in support of its Motion to Strike no later than **September 30**, **2019**. If the Agency elects not to file a reply brief, it shall notify the Tribunal of its intention.
