ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO MODIFY CONFERENCE DEADLINES

A Prehearing Order was issued in this matter directing the parties, *inter alia*, to engage in a settlement conference on or before January 20, 2010 and directing Complainant to file a status report regarding settlement on or before January 25, 2010. Accordingly, the parties are directed to engage in a settlement conference on or before **January 27, 2010**, and attempt to reach an amicable resolution of this matter. The Complainant shall file a status report regarding the progress of settlement efforts on or before **February 1, 2010**.
