- Johnson & Johnson Pharmaceutical Research and Development (PRD) is located in San Diego, California, in the Torrey Pines area near the Scripps and Burnham Institutes.
- The site houses approximately 400 scientists working in the area of basic drug discovery aimed at creating medicines that address unmet medical needs in the areas of metabolic diseases, cardiovascular disease, inflammation and immunological disease, pain, and neuroscience.
- The facility is over 300,000 square feet consisting primarily of chemistry and biology laboratories.
- As with all Johnson & Johnson companies, we are dedicated to creating a sustainable presence in our community and as such, are a LEED-certified Green Facility, one of the top Green Power producers in the US, and the recipient of awards from the US EPA and The Climate Group.
