The Propylene Oxide Panel (Panel) of the American Chemistry Council, on behalf of its member companies,¹ submits this letter to inform EPA of the status of publication of the manuscript concerning propylene oxide (CASRN 75-56-9) referred to in the Panel's letter of December 11, 2001 (8EHQ-1201-15030) and the study referred to in the Panel's earlier letter of July 11, 2000 (8EHQ-0796-13687-Supplement).

The paper entitled "*Analysis of DNA and hemoglobin adducts and sister chromatid exchanges in a human population occupationally exposed to propylene oxide: a pilot study*," now has been published in the journal *Cancer Epidemiology Biomarkers and Prevention*, Volume 11(3), pages 315 - 318.
