Elf Atochem North America, Inc. (Elf Atochem) is submitting results of primary skin irritation studies in rabbits to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) on a "For Your Information (FYI)" basis. The studies provide information on 3-isopropoxypropylamine (CAS No. 2906-12-9) and 3-bromopropionic acid (CAS No. 590-92-1). They do not involve effects in humans.

Nothing in this letter is considered confidential business information of Elf Atochem.

Elf Atochem does not currently manufacture, import or market these chemical substances.

The results of the studies showed 3-bromopropionic acid to be corrosive to rabbit skin after a 4-hour exposure and 3-isopropoxypropylamine to be corrosive after a 3-minute exposure.
