On October 26, 1977, BASF Corporation submitted the results of acute toxicity studies with triphenylphosphine (CAS No. 603-35-0). BASF Corporation is now submitting acute aquatic toxicity data recently received from BASF Aktiengesellschaft, Ludwigshafen, Germany. Although we do not feel that the information presents a substantial risk to health or the environment, it is being submitted under Section 8(e) of TSCA.

New information for this material indicates that the 48hr LC₍₅₀₎ to Daphnia magna is 0.6 mg/l.

This information will be communicated to persons handling the material via updated Material Safety Data Sheets.
