Subject: Notice in Accordance with TSCA Section 8(e) — Results of Ecological Toxicity Testing with 3- Phenoxy-benzaldehyde conducted by BASF Aktiengesellschaft, Ludwigshafen, Germany

BASF Corporation is submitting results of an acute toxicity study on *Daphnia magna* with 3- phenoxy-benzaldehyde (CAS 39515-51-0) conducted by BASF Aktiengesellschaft, Ludwigshafen, Germany. The test was conducted in accordance with the following guidelines: OECD 202 and EPA OPPTS 850.1010.

Results:

Daphnia magna: 48-hr EC50 = 0.8 mg/L

Although the findings are not considered to present a substantial risk to human health or the environment, BASF Corporation understands that reporting of results from this study under TSCA 8(e) is in accordance with EPA's policy.
