

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Recently BASF Corporation submitted information regarding the acute inhalation toxicity of 2,3,5-trimethylhydroquinone (CAS No. 700-13-0). Additional information has been received from BASF Aktiengesellschaft, Ludwigshafen, Germany, indicating that the 48 hour EC<sub>50</sub> of this material to Daphnia magna is 0.97 mg/l. Although BASF does not feel that this represents a substantial risk to the environment, the information is being submitted as a supplement to the file.

BASF does not market this chemical; however, employees will be notified of the information as part of OSHA required Hazard Communication training.
