Subject: Notice in accordance with Section 8(e) - Results of acute toxicity of Reg. No. 94/11009 in Zebra fish.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

BASF Corporation is submitting the results of an acute toxicity study of Reg. No. 94/11009 in Zebra fish. The NOEC was determined to be 0.001 mg/l. The study was conducted by BASF Aktiengesellschaft, Ludwigshafen, Germany.

The chemical identity of this developmental insecticide is "substituted N-phenyl pyrazole".

Small shipments, totalling about 0.34 kg of product, have been received by BASF Corporation for Research and Developmental purposes. This information will be communicated to all persons handling the material.
