

This letter is to inform you of the preliminary results of recently completed inhalation studies in rats.

Groups of four rats were exposed to the test material by inhalation. Exposure to an atmospheric concentration of 195,000 ppm for four hours caused narcosis in the rats after a period of approximately one hour. All rats recovered quickly after cessation of exposure. Exposure to an atmospheric concentration of 135,000 ppm for four hours caused no effects.

The effects described above were observed at extremely high concentrations; hence, we do not believe that they are indicative of substantial risk. However, the results are being reported based upon EPA guidance.

The test material is a research chemical and the exposure potential is very limited. Therefore, we wish to claim [red bracket] chemical identity as confidential business information. ~~Substantiation in support of our confidentiality claim is enclosed.~~

We will forward a copy of the final report of the study to EPA when it is available.



