This letter is in response to the Agency's letter of December 17, 2002, requesting additional information on the uses of the test mixture and other available information to assist in assessing potential exposures, as well as any voluntary risk management actions.

The test mixture evaluated in the study reported to EPA has not been commercialized. At the time the reported test was conducted, this material was under research and development evaluation as a potential antistatic agent. Its intended application would have been limited to industrial use. The substance was being evaluated by a single potential customer for application to one of their products for institutional use. Although this material had good antistatic performance, other properties related to the ability of the treated product to be handled by existing equipment was unsatisfactory. The potential customer has completed their evaluation and this development program has been terminated. No other use for the material has been identified and there are no current plans for further development or commercialization.
